Green Rising unites Goodwall and Generation Unlimited (UNICEF), alongside SAP and Accenture, in a strategic partnership to unleash youth potential at scale to tackle the climate crisis head-on.

Three core approaches to mobilize youth for our planet



DO

A series of gamified upskilling challenges to complete sustainable tasks in local communities, from tree planting to recycling.



AMPLIFY

A youth-led think tank amplifying youth voices and giving them a seat at the table at key international events (i.e. COP28, UNGA).



INNOVATE

An innovation competition for grassroots green ideas and solutions. The best ideas receive funding through results-based microgrants and are shared to inspire others.

How we will measure impact

Quantitative Data: live dashboard monitoring various metrics such as youth actions, participation, engagement and reach through the program.

Qualitative Surveying: compile photo and video user-generated evidence of actions, and gather participants insights and feedback.

Impact Stories: identify and amplify individual youth stories to give perspective on the data.
